Transport Agreement 2023/24

Sixth formers are expected to behave in a responsible way when using transport to/from school or on a school trip. When in uniform out of school hours, you are representing the sixth form and must model 'Best Behaviours' for younger pupils. This helps ensure a safe and stress-free journey for all.

As a passenger I will.....

- act in an orderly, considerate manner when getting on/off and during the journey
- show respect for the driver and other passengers, remain seated throughout the journey or, if standing, not distract the driver or stand beyond the safe zone,
- report damage (accidental or otherwise) or concerns about inappropriate behaviour.
- be an 'upstander' not a 'bystander' This means reporting any poor behaviour ASAP to the sixth form team, taking mobile phone recordings if possible and trying to get names.

Note – you are never expected to put yourself in danger when experiencing poor behaviour but you are expected to pass on information, names or footage that will help us identify pupils involved.

As a passenger I will not.....

- cause criminal damage, vandalise or graffiti the vehicle,
- damage/mask CCTV cameras
- use abusive language or intimidate other passengers,
- 'bully' younger pupils into giving up their seat
- steal or damage safety equipment,
- use a forged pass or avoid paying fares,
- cause danger eg: by opening emergency doors, carrying dangerous items, making tripping hazards in the aisle or throwing objects in/from the bus.
