Revision

Remaining time is given to support revision of Paper 1 and Paper 2 topics along with exam skills preparation.



Paper 3 – Elective Ideology

Students complete Paper 3 with a focus on an optional ideology. We have typically looked at feminism.



Paper 3 - Core Ideologies

Students examine the core political ideologies of Liberalism, Socialism and Conservatism. They explore origins, core ideas, key thinkers and tensions within the ideology.



Yr12 Assessments

At the end of Y12 all students will have completed a full Paper 1 mock (UK) and Paper 2 (US and Comparative Politics)



Paper 2 – US Politics

Students explore the politics of the US system and also the comparative nature to the UK. Topics include elections, political parties, pressure groups and civil rights



Paper 1 – UK Politics

Students explore the UK political system looking at democracy, elections and referendums, political parties, pressure groups and the UK relationship with the EU



Paper 2 – US Government

Students explore the US Constitution, the branches of government and the issue of federalism. They also compare these to the UK system of Government.

Sociological study of education including theories of education, education policies and differential educational achievement by social group.
